Journeyman Plumbing License Course

JPLM 900

The Journeyman Plumbing course is designed to assist students preparing to write the Journeyman Plumbing Examination. Topics includes: interpretation of codes, disposal and drainage systems, storm drainage disposal systems, installation of sanitary fixtures, basic drawings to scale, water supply and distribution, use of materials and tools, repairs and maintenance. To fulfill the course requirements, candidates must complete all assigned course-work. All students will be exposed to a comprehensive drill conducted by the Ministry of Public Works

Individuals that have attained the Journeyman Plumbing License are qualified for automatic entry into the Master Plumbing License Course.

Master Plumbing License Course

MPLM 900

The Master Plumbing course is designed to assist students preparing to write the Master Plumbing Examination. Students should have above average knowledge and skills in interpretation of codes, disposal and drainage systems, storm drainage disposal systems, installation of sanitary fixtures, water supply and distribution repairs and maintenance. Special emphasis will be placed on plant management and foreman responsibilities.

Prerequisite: Journeyman Plumber's License
