Classes Begin at the New Northern Bahamas Campus

The College of The Bahamas wishes to notify its students and the public-at-large of the expected opening of the new campus on January 10, 2011, which is the scheduled College start date for the upcoming Spring Semester.

At this time all degree programmes, with the exception of the Culinary and Hospitality Management Institute (CHMI) programmes, will be moving to the new campus. Culinary and Hospitality Management courses along with Continuing Education and Extension Services (CEES) will remain at the current campus site, for the time being.

With the exception of CHMI and CEES students, all registered students should therefore report to the new campus on January 10th. Students who have not yet registered should note that during the week of January 4, 2011, all advisement, registration and related students services will be carried out at the current campus site, as normal. These services will not be available at the new site until the start of classes on January 10.

Installation of furniture and equipment at the new campus is near completion. Information technology and other communication services are being tested and are expected to be up and running for the semester's start.

Students should expect a further update regarding the provision of other ancillary services in the days prior to the start of the semester.
